The DNA Code & the Tabernacle and Temple

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DNA in the Bible

The Bible contains symbols for a reason: these symbols help our simple minds understand the deep things of God. As you look at the example of symbolism below, I ask you a simple question: could the Word of God, compared to the incorruptible seed mentioned in 1 Peter 1:23, be symbolized in the Bible for DNA? If God's Word says in (Hebrews 13:8) "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever." Could we not surmise that the Word, compared to the seed, is not poetic but symbolic?

The study of DNA is less than 200 years old, yet as you will see in these studies, God, who made seed and human DNA, signified by the numbers 23 and 46, is found in multiple examples for doctrine. Consider the examples below of symbolism in the Bible:

The Lamb: An actual lamb was sacrificed in the book of Exodus. Later in the New Testament, we see Jesus Christ presented as the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

Water: A bronze laver was used by the priests in the Old Testament to wash themselves so they could enter the Tabernacle since death would have been the consequence had they not been washed. The spiritual Rock that followed the Hebrews through the wilderness was Christ. Moses was instructed to hit the Rock once, just as Christ was smitten once for our sins, making it possible for the Holy Spirit, the Comforter, to come. In the New Testament, water symbolizes the Holy Spirit.

TEMPLE - The temple in the Old Testament was an actual building representing the body of Jesus Christ. In the New Testament, Jesus compares his body to the temple, stating, "... *Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up*" (John 2:19).

The Table of Showbread – On the table were 12 loves, signifying the 12 tribes of Israel. Each week on the Sabbath, the bread was replaced. This bread symbolizes the true bread of life, Jesus Christ. Just like manna was the spiritual meat the Hebrews ate in the wilderness, we need our daily bread to survive spiritually each day.

POMOGRANATES – A symbol worn on the high priest's hem. The Temple Institute mentions on its website that the pomegranate contains around 613 seeds, the same number of laws the Lamb of God fulfilled when he died for our sins. The seeds are blood-red, symbolizing death, and the skin inside the pomegranate resembles snake skin. Jesus is the serpent lifted up on a pole in the Old Testament.

As you look at each study, remember the number of occurrences you seed the numbers 23 and 46 appear and ask, when does something look to be by design and not by chance?

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God Led the People

"The Cloud" Found in 23 chapters of the O.T.

(1 Corinthians 10:4) "And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ." (Contains 23 words)

The Temple

Solomon Instructed to Build the Temple


King David hoped to build the temple, but God said he had spilled too much blood. God chose David's son, Solomon. The man God chose to rebuild His Temple becomes king in the 23rd chapter of 1 Chronicles.

"The house of God" found 23 times of 2 Chronicles – book where King Solomon is instructed to build the house of God.

The Measurement of the Tabernacle and Temple

"Five Cubits" is found in 23 verses of the Bible.

Notice the measurments in meters below. The Tabernacle is 46 x 23 meters



The Third Temple

(Revelation 21:22-23) "And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. {23} And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof."

"Light" Found in 46 books of the Bible

The Oracle

First occurrence of the word "Oracle" found in 2 Sameul 16:23. According to the Henry Morris study Bible, the Oracle was the innermost sanctuary, corresponding to the "Most Holy Place." It housed the ark of the covenant, and was also called the "Holiest of all," Hebrews 9:3.

(2 Chronicles 5:7) "And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, to the oracle of the house, into the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims:"

"Covenant" is found in 23 chapters of Genesis (First mention of Covenant)

"Serve" found in 23 chapters of Exodus

(1 Samuel 12:24) "Only fear the LORD, and <u>serve him</u> in truth with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you." (Contains 23 Words)

The Veil

"Curtain" Found 23 times in the book of Exodus

(Hebrews 10:20) "By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;"

Highlighted words found in 46 chapters of Exodus and 23 times in Ezekiel (Why is that important? The book of Exodus is where Moses received the plans for the Tabernacle and the book of Ezekiel is where the 3rd temple is mentioned)

(Exodus 26:31) "And thou shalt make a vail of

fine twined linen of cunning work: with

cherubims shall it be made:"

(Luke 23:45) "And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst."

"Temple of" Found 46 times in the Bible

"The House" Found in 46 Books of the Bible & 23 verses of Leviticus

"My House" Found 23 times, in 23 verses of the O.T.


(Psalms 23:6) "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and <u>I will</u>

(1 Corinthians 3:17) "If any man defile <u>the temple</u> of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are." (Contains 23 words, 46th book of the Bible)

There are three in the Godhead, God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. I find it fascinating that "**A sanctuary**" is found 3 times, in 3 verses, in 3 chapters, and in 3 books of the Bible. The Tabernacle and temple had 3 areas.



Holy Anointing Oil

(Exodus 30:31-33) "And thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, <u>This shall be an holy anointing oil unto me throughout your generations</u>. {32} Upon man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall ye make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy unto you. {33} Whosoever compoundeth any like it, or whosoever putteth any of it upon a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people."

"Oil" Found 23 times in the book of Exodus

Ingredients to the Holy Oil:

(Exodus 30:23-24) "Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred shekels, and of sweet cinnamon half so much, even two hundred and fifty shekels, and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty shekels, {24} And of cassia five hundred shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary, and of oil olive an hin:"

All 5 ingredients found in 23 Verses of the Bible

Oil used to Sanctify:

(Leviticus 8:10) "And Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that was therein, and sanctified them."

"Sanctified" - Found 46 times in the Old Testament.

The Feasts of the Lord

"The Sabbath" Found in 46 verses of the N.T.

"Sabbath Day" Found 23 times in the O.T.

"The Passover" Found in 23 verses of the N.T.

7 feasts are listed below. Notice what chapter they are found in ...the 23rd chapter of Leviticus

- 1. **The Passover Feast** Pointed to the Messiah as our Passover lamb (Leviticus 23:5)
- 2. **The Feast of Unleavened Bread** Pointed to the Messiah's sinless life (Leviticus 23:6)
- 3. **The Feast of First Fruits** Pointed to the Messiah's resurrection as the first fruits of the righteous. (Leviticus 23:10)
- 4. **The Feast of Pentecost** Pointed to the great harvest of souls and the gift of the Holy Spirit for both Jew and Gentile. (Leviticus 23:16)
- 5. **the Feast of Trumpets** Points to Israel being gathered back to their land. (Leviticus 23:24)
- 6. The Day of Atonement Israel's annual cleansing from sin (Leviticus 23:27)
- 7. **The Feast of Tabernacles** Points to Israels Millennial Rest when Jesus will rule. (Leviticus 23:34)

The Door

Words Found the same numbers as DNA, 23 & 46

"The door of the tabernacle of the congregation" is found in 23 times and 23 chapters of Leviticus. The book we find the feasts.

"Door" Found in 23 books of the O.T. and 23 chapters of Exodus (the book that instructs the building of the Tabernacle)

"The Door" Found in 23 verses of the New Testament

(Exodus 12:23) "For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the blood upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you."

The Tabernacle's Materials

(Exodus 25:3-7) "And this is the offering which ye shall take of them; gold, and silver, and brass, {4} And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' hair, {5} And rams' skins dyed red, and badgers' skins, and shittim wood, {6} Oil for the light, spices for anointing oil, and for sweet incense, {7} Onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod, and in the breastplate."

Notice the 4 groupings and how they are laid out in this passage.

Located in Ezekiel chapters 40-46 is the future Temple used during Christ's millennial reign. How do we know this Temple is this future Temple? Because the dimensions given in Ezekiel describe a grand temple that exceeds all previous Temples.

(Contains 46 Words)

Table of Shewbread

Words Found the same numbers as DNA, 23 & 46

"The Bread" Found 46 times in 46 Verses of the Bible
"Bread" Found 23 times in Leviticus (the book we get the feasts)

"Table" Found in 46 chapters of the O.T.

"Shittim Wood" Found 23 times and in 23 chapters of Genesis

(Psalms 23:5) "Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over."

(Exodus 25:23) "Thou shalt also make <u>a table</u> of <u>shittim wood</u>: two cubits shall be the length thereof, and a cubit the breadth thereof, and a cubit and a half the height thereof."

(Exodus 26:35) "And thou shalt set the **table** without the vail, and the candlestick over against the table on the side of the tabernacle toward <u>the south</u>: and thou shalt put the **table** on the <u>north side</u>."

"The South" Found in 23 books of the Bible.

The number 14 is defined for salvation and deliverance in the King James Bible. **Passover is on the 14th day**. Notice how the word **"Bread"** is found in the three gospels, Godhead.

"**Burnt**" Found in 23 books of the O.T. – the meat offering had to be burnt – Leviticus 6:<mark>23</mark>

"An Offering made by Fire" Found in 23 chapters of Leviticus

"The Bullock" Found 23 times in Leviticus

"Offering" Found in 23 books of the O.T.

"The altar of the Lord" Found 23 times in the Bible

"An Altar" Found in 46 verses of the O.T.

The Altar of the Tabernacle is five cubits long and five cubits broad, foursquare (Ex 27:1).

"Five Cubits," Found in 23 verses of the Bible.

(Exodus 27:3) "And thou shalt make <u>his pans</u> to receive <u>his ashes</u>, and <u>his shovels</u>, and <u>his basons</u>, and <u>his fleshhooks</u>, and <u>his firepans</u>: all the vessels thereof thou shalt make of brass."

"His" is the peg word. All six items listed after the word "His" are found in 46 chapters of the Old Testament.

(Hebrews 9:19) "For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the <u>blood of calves</u> and of <u>goats</u>, with <u>water</u>, and <u>scarlet wool</u>, and <u>hyssop</u>, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,"

5 items listed found in 46 books of the Bible.

Dedication of the Temple

(2 Chronicles 5:2) "Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion." (Contains 46 words)

(2 Chronicles 7:15-16) "Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer that is made in this place. {16} For now have I chosen and sanctified this house, that my name may be there for ever: and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually." (Contains 46 words)

Solomon had spent 7 days in dedication of the altar and seven days for the feast. It is on the 23rd day that Solomon sends the people away.

(2 Chronicles 7:10) "And on the <u>three and twentieth day</u> of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and merry in heart for the goodness that the LORD had shewed unto David, and to Solomon, and to Israel his people."

(Joshua 6:24) "And they burnt the city with fire, and all that was therein: only the silver, and the gold, and the vessels of brass and of iron, they put into the treasury of the house of the LORD."

Urim and Thummim

The placement of the Urim and Thummim was inside the breastplate of judgment upon the High Priest's heart. Why? That the heart of the High Priest would be in tune with the desires of God. These two stones somehow revealed the judgments and decisions of God. How this

occurred is a mystery. But this we know, according to Webster's 1828 Dictionary, the Urim and Thummim signified "Lights" and "perfections."

(Exodus 28:30) "And thou shalt put in the breastplate of judgment the Urim and the Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually." **(Contains 46 words)**

"Breastplate" Found 23 times in the book of Exodus, the same book where the pattern for the Tabernacle is given to Moses.

Agron Anointed


(Leviticus 8:23) "And he slew it; and Moses <u>took of the blood</u> of it, and put it upon the tip of Aaron's <u>right ear</u>, and upon the <u>thumb of his right hand</u>, and upon the <u>great toe of his right foot</u>."

In Leviticus 8:23, Moses takes blood and applies it to the tip of Aaron's right ear, right thumb, and right toe. The three areas, signifying the Trinity, reveal a vessel unto good works under the blood. It would be impossible to grasp anything without the use of the thumb, impossible to balance and walk without the big toe, but most important, it would be impossible to hear from God without the blood of Jesus Christ.

Mitre

(Exodus 28:36-37) "And thou shalt make a plate of pure gold, and grave upon it, like the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD. {37} And thou shalt put it on a blue lace, that it may be upon the mitre; upon the forefront of the mitre it shall be."

Pomegranate



According to Epoch News and Gotquestions.org they say tradition has it the **pomegranate contains 613 seeds**, the **same number of laws found in the Torah that Jesus Christ fulfilled at the cross.** For starters, what color is pomegranate juice, and what does it look like? The answer is blood. Pomegranates are full of blood-like seeds symbolic of Jesus, the chosen seed who would die for the world's sins. "

Pomegranates" Found 23 times in the Bible

(Matthew 1:21) "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins." (Contains 23 words)

No surprise, but the Serpent spoke precisely **46** words to Eve when tempting her to take of the fruit Genesis **3:1-5**, the number for human DNA. Notice these two pictures. The membrane of the pomegranate looks remarkably like the skin of a snake.

Ephod, Girdle and Breastplate

"**Ephod**" Found in 23 chapters of Exodus

The Ephod, Girdle, and breastplate made from 5 colors. All 5 colors found in 46 books of the Bible

• Ephod materials (Ex 28:5-6)

Gold, blue, purple, scarlet, and twined linen

• Girdle of the Ephod (Ex 28:8)

Gold, blue, purple, scarlet, and twined linen

• Breastplate of Judgment (Ex 28:15)

Gold, blue, purple, scarlet, and twined linen

This breastplate contained 12 stones representing the 12 tribes of Israel. It was worn upon Aaron's heart before the Lord to bear the judgment of the children of Israel.

(Exodus 28:30) "And thou shalt put in the <u>breastplate of judgment</u> the Urim and the Thummim; and they shall <u>be upon Aaron's heart</u>, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel <u>upon his heart before the LORD</u> continually." (Contains 46 Words)

(Exodus 28:12) "And thou shalt put the two stones_upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial unto the children of Israel: and Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial."

"Memorial" Found in 23 chapters of the O.T.

Job of the High Priest

(Ezekiel 44:23) "And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean."

Notice the peg word "to."

(2 Chronicles 29:11) "My sons, be not now negligent: for the LORD hath chosen you

to stand before him.

to serve him,

and that ye should minister unto him, and burn incense." (King Hezekiah is speaking to the Levites)

Both underlined phrases are found together in 23 chapters of the O.T.

(2 Chronicles 29:15) "And they gathered their brethren, and <u>sanctified</u> themselves, and came, according to the commandment of the king, by the words of the LORD, to cleanse the house of the LORD." (The Levites sanctified themselves after Hezekiah gave the command)

"Sanctified" Found 46 times in the O.T.

Notice the peg below, it's the word "without."

(2 Chronicles 15:3) "Now for a long season Israel hath been

without **the true God**, and

without a teaching priest, and

without **law**."

Highlighted words found in 46 books of the Bible

Who is the Prince in the book of Ezekiel?

"The Prince" is found in 46 verses of the Old Testament

In the 46th chapter of Ezekiel we see a man named "The Prince." Is this man the Messiah? Let us look at a quote from Gotquestions for a moment and see what they say about the Prince of Ezekiel:

According to premillennial, dispensational theology, this section of Ezekiel describes the worship of the Lord that will take place during the future 1,000-year reign of Christ on earth during the millennium (see Revelation 20). Christ will be reigning in Jerusalem. There will be a temple, the massive size of which is detailed by Ezekiel. The prince mentioned in Ezekiel 46, it appears, is the leader of the nation of Israel during this time. He is the representative of the nation of Israel and will bring offerings to the Lord and provide an example of devout worship.

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
