DNA in the Bible

The Bible contains symbols for a reason: these symbols help our simple minds understand the deep things of God. As you look at the example of symbolism below, I ask you a simple question: could the Word of God, compared to the incorruptible seed mentioned in 1 Peter 1:23, be symbolized in the Bible for DNA? If God's Word says in (Hebrews 13:8) "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever." Could we not surmise that the Word, compared to the seed, is not poetic but symbolic?

The study of DNA is less than 200 years old, yet as you will see in these studies, God, who made seed and human DNA, signified by the numbers 23 and 46, is found in multiple examples for doctrine. Consider the examples below of symbolism in the Bible:

The Lamb: An actual lamb was sacrificed in the book of Exodus. Later in the New Testament, we see Jesus Christ presented as the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

Water: A bronze laver was used by the priests in the Old Testament to wash themselves so they could enter the Tabernacle since death would have been the consequence had they not been washed. The spiritual Rock that followed the Hebrews through the wilderness was Christ. Moses was instructed to hit the Rock once, just as Christ was smitten once for our sins, making it possible for the Holy Spirit, the Comforter, to come. In the New Testament, water symbolizes the Holy Spirit.

TEMPLE - The temple in the Old Testament was an actual building representing the body of Jesus Christ. In the New Testament, Jesus compares his body to the temple, stating, "... *Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up*" (John 2:19).

The Table of Showbread – On the table were 12 loves, signifying the 12 tribes of Israel. Each week on the Sabbath, the bread was replaced. This bread symbolizes the true bread of life, Jesus Christ. Just like manna was the spiritual meat the Hebrews ate in the wilderness, we need our daily bread to survive spiritually each day.

POMOGRANATES – A symbol worn on the high priest's hem. The Temple Institute mentions on its website that the pomegranate contains around 613 seeds, the same number of laws the Lamb of God fulfilled when he died for our sins. The seeds are blood-red, symbolizing death, and the skin inside the pomegranate resembles snake skin. Jesus is the serpent lifted up on a pole in the Old Testament.

As you look at each study, remember the number of occurrences you seed the numbers 23 and 46 appear and ask, when does something look to be by design and not by chance?

"Authority" Found in 23 chapters of the N.T.

"In that Day" Found in 23 books of the Bible (Henry Morris Study Bible, explains this phrase refers to "The Day of the Lord."

"The Power of..." Found in 46 chapters of the Bible

"War" Found in 23 books of the O.T.

"His power" found in 23 chapters of the Bible

"Desolation" Found 46 times and in 46 verses of the Bible

"Sackcloth" Found 46 times in the Bible

"Cast Out" Found in 23 Chapters of N.T.

"The Tongue" Found in 23 verses of the Bible

"Day of the Lord" Found in 23 verses of the Bible

"Arms" Found in 23 chapters (crucifixion)

(Isaiah 51:5) "My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust."

"Mountain" Found in 23 verses of N.T.

(Daniel 2:35) "Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth."

(Hosea 9:7) "The days of visitation are come, the days of recompense are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a fool, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of thine iniquity, and the great hatred."

Pegs "The days of" and "are come."

"Visitation" and "Recompence" are found in 23 verses of the O.T.

(Revelation 19:2) "For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand."

Pegs are "hath" and "the."

"Judged" and "Avenged" found 46 times in the O.T.

(Isaiah 28:15-18) "Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves: {16} Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste. {17} Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. {18} ¶ And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it."

"Death" and "Hell" Found together in 46 books of the Bible.

- (1 Kings 14:23) "For they also built them high places, and images, and groves, on every high hill, and under every green tree."
- (2 Chronicles 24:20) "And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you." (Contains 23 words)
- (1 Kings 12:24) "Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren the children of Israel: return every man to his house; for this thing is from me. They hearkened therefore to the word of the LORD, and returned to depart, according to the word of the LORD." (Contains 46 words spoken by God)
- (Luke 9:24) "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it." (Contains 23 words)
 - (Philippians 2:10) "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;" (Contains 23 Words)

(Revelation 14:15) "And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, <u>Thrust in thy sickle</u>, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe." (Contains 23 words)

(Matthew 13:48-49) "Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away. {49} So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just," (Both the yellow and green have 23 words for a total of 46)

(Jeremiah 23:5) "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth."

Jesus our High Priest will one day come through the "Eastern Gate." The first time he came through the "Eastern Gate" was on a colt, Luke 19:37-38, the second time will be on a horse, Revelation 19:11-14, with the armies of God at the second advent. What is interesting is His return is found in the 46th chapter of Ezekiel verses 1-2.

(Isaiah 46:9-10) "Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, {10} Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:"

(Judges 2:16) "Nevertheless the LORD raised up <u>judges</u>, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them."

"Judges" Found in 23 books of the Bible.

(Exodus 12:29) "And it came to pass, that at <u>midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt,</u> from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle." (Contains 46 words)

(Jeremiah 44:23) "Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day." (Contains 46 words)

(1 Corinthians 3:17) "If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are." (Contains 23 words)

(Acts 28:26) "Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive:"_(Contains 23 words)

(**Exodus** 23:23) "For mine Angel shall go before thee, and bring thee in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and <u>I</u> will cut them off."

(Matthew 12:34) "O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh." (Contains 23 words)

(Ephesians 4:19-20) "Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. {20} But ye have not so learned Christ;" (Contains 23 words)

23rd Chapter of Mathew involves Christ rebuking the Pharisees and Scribes.

(Revelation 7:3) "Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads." (Contains 23 words)

(Romans 16:20) "And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen." (Contains 23 words)

Moses

(Exodus 4:1) "And Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto thee."

(Moses speaks to God using 23 words that to God. Who is Moses speaking to? The answer is Jesus Christ

God of Abraham

God of Isaac

God of Jacob

The three together are found in 23 chapters of the O.T.

Prophecy

Words Found the same numbers as DNA, 23 & 46

"Taken You" and "Brought You" Found 23 times in the Bible

(**Deuteronomy 4:20**) "But the LORD hath <u>taken you</u>, and <u>brought you</u> forth out of the iron furnace, even out of Egypt, to be unto him a people of inheritance, as ye are this day."

"It Shall Come to Pass in that Day" Phrase Found 23 times and in 23 Verses of the Bible
"It Shall Come to pass that" Phrase Found 46 times and in 46 verses of the Bible

"Mighty Hand" and "Stretched out Arm" found in 23 verses of the O.T.

(Deuteronomy 5:15) "And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day."

(Hosea 2:19-20) "And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. {20} I will even betroth thee unto me in faithfulness: and thou shalt know the LORD."

All four highlighted words are found in 23 books of the N.T. (notice the peg is the word "in")

(Deuteronomy 8:6) "Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him."

"Walk in his ways" and "Fear Him" found in 23 chapters of O.T. (Peg is "To")

(**Deuteronomy 4:45)** "These are **the testimonies**, and **the statutes**, and **the judgments**, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt,"

All highlighted words found in 23 books of the O.T. (peg is "the")

"Statutes" and "Judgments" are found in 23 books of the O.T.

- (1 Kings 8:23) "And he said, LORD God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and mercy with thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart:"
- . **(Zechariah 8:23)** "Thus saith the LORD of hosts: In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: for we have heard that God is with you."
- (1 Kings 8:51) "For they be <u>thy people</u>, and <u>thine inheritance</u>, which thou broughtest forth out of Egypt, from the midst of the furnace of iron:" (Contains 23 words)
 - (Hosea 12:3-4) "He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God: {4} Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him in Beth–el, and there he spake with us;" (Contains 46 Words)

"**Zion**" Found 46 times in Isaiah (23rd book)

"City of David" Found 46 times and in 46 verses of the Bible

Jerusalem" Found in 46 chapters of Isaiah (23rd book)

"Bethlehem" Found in 23 chapters of the Bible

"My Name" Found 23 times and in 23 verses of the N.T.

(Hebrews 11:16) "But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city."

"A City" Found in 23 books of the Bible

(1 Kings 11:36) "And unto his son will I give one tribe, that David my servant may have a light alway before me in **Jerusalem**, **the city** which I have chosen me to put **my name** there."

(Nehemiah 1:9) "But if ye turn unto me, and keep my commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, yet will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set **my name** there."

The 12 Spies Bring Back the Fruit of the Promised Land

(Numbers 13:23) And they came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff; and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs.

The Mark of the Beast

(Revelation 13:16) "And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:"

"Right Hand & Forehead" found 46 times and in 46 verses of the N.T.

Antichrist

"The Beast" - Found 46 times in the Bible

(1 John 2:22) "Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son." (Contains 23 Words)

(**Daniel 11:36**) "And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done."

(**Contains 46 Words**)

Esther & the 23rd Day

On the 23rd day of the 3rd month, Mordecai sent out a decree written in many languages, a plan to save the people from the evil of Haman—notice who is behind the saving of the Jews: God. Notice the date Mordecai made this decree; it is in the 3rd month on the 23rd day.

Esther 8:9 Then were the king's scribes called at that time in the third month, that is, the month Sivan, on the three and twentieth day thereof; and it was written according to all that Mordecai commanded unto the Jews, and to the lieutenants, and the deputies and rulers of the provinces which are from India unto Ethiopia, an hundred twenty and seven provinces, unto every province according to the writing thereof, and unto every people after their language, and to the Jews according to their writing, and according to their language.

The Basket

What does the basket represent? Or better asked, WHO does the basket represent?

"Basket" Found 23 times in the Bible

(Deuteronomy 26:4) "And the priest shall take the <u>basket</u> out of thine hand, and set it down before <u>the altar of the LORD</u> thy God." (Contain 23 words)

Occurrences in the Bible for "Basket"

- 1. **Aaron** and **his sons ate** out of the **basket** by the **door of the Tabernacle** (Ex 29)
- 2. There was a **basket of Consecration** (Le 8:31)
- 3. Carried **unleavened bread** (Le 8:2, 26 Nu 6:15)
- 4. **Paul saved** in a basket (2 Co 11:33)
- 5. One basket contained **good figs** (Je 24:2)
- 6. **Gideon** placed **flesh** in the **basket** he brought before the angel of the Lord (Ju 6:19)
- 7. First fruit of **all the fruit** of the earth placed in a basket brought to a priest and the basket was **placed before the altar** of the Lord (De 26)
- 8. God would bless the basket of his people if they hearkened diligently to his commands, or he would curse their basket if they did not. (De 28)

Judgment Seat of Christ

Words Found the same numbers as DNA, 23 & 46

"A crown" Found 23 times and in 23 verses of the Bible

(2 Timothy 4:8) "Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing."
